Actions from last site visit remain the same as from last monitoring visit:

- Condition 7 requires action. Update: No action.
- Condition 13 and 30 requires action each period/as notified. Update: Kept on as reminder.
- Separation of stockpiles from perimeter soil bunding. Update: One stockpile nearest entrance now infringing onto site perimeter bunding.
- Overburden/stockpiles heights to be monitored. Update: To be monitored by operator.

Inspection Results Summary:

- Tipped aggregate near weighbridge.
- Site entrance with bellmouth clean at time of visit.
- Internal haul road in good condition.
- Perimeter mounds around site now infested with thistles.
- Lagoons on far western side now continue to have establishing vegetation both within and on perimeter banking.
- Lagoons in central area of site comprises principally two larger main water holding areas and one smaller to the west. Western most lagoon now having significant vegetation growth in its base. Central extended lagoon has vegetation within its western side and exposed silt to the east. New lagoon created in eastern most void base and now filled with water.
- Evidence of sand martin/rabbit holes in northern facing bank of unworked mineral.
- Excavations have now been completed within the eastern side of the footprint and excavations moving westward.
- Backfilling along the eastern boundary has been completed and a buffer of backfill extends out some 6-8 metres.
- Sump on far eastern side partially filled with water.
- Central graded stockpile of overburden remains in place with further loose tipped overburden in piles placed on its western side near processing plant.
- DH thought another 18 months working of reserve left.
- Within processing plant area, plant producing gravel/stone product.
- Sand stockpile adjacent processing plant now holding more sand than previous visit.
- Central band of mineral remains to be worked.

- Clearance of tipped aggregate near weighbridge.
